With the NOJHL Showcase returning, following a two-year hiatus, due to COVID-19 restrictions, the two-day event, Oct. 4-5, will provide exciting on-ice action featuring all 12 leagues teams competing under one roof, which will allow you to scout all of our players at one venue, the Gerry McCrory Countryside Sports Complex in Sudbury.
